The <u>launch of the Night Tube</u> has been deferred to allow a successful conclusion to talks with the trade unions. The decision will allow time for an agreement to be reached to avoid further strikes and begin night services this autumn.

Victoria line services up and running two days early following a closure between Seven Sisters and Walthamstow for major works. LU and a number of our suppliers, including Kilnbridge, Siemens, Cheema, Progress Rail and others, completed the biggest Tube line closure of a railway in 15 years, installing the biggest and fastest underground crossover on the network and one of the biggest in the world. Thank you and well done to everyone involved.





TfL took over Great Eastern services between Liverpool Street and Shenfield in May. Re-named TfL Rail, these services form part of Crossrail which will open fully in December 2019.
