




- 300 mm sewer diversion

- Monitoring






















## KG Update Oct – Dec 2015



### **Environmental Monitoring**

Noise: 2 unattended continuous monitors 1 attended noise and vibration monitoring visit

**Dust** 5 dust slide locations**Vibration** 2 weeks during the start of pilling works

### **Monitoring Results Summary**

- 0 noise exceedance, (6 amber alerts from piling works)
- 1 dust exceedance GS3
- 30 vibration exceedances (>1mm/s but < 2mm/s)</li>





#### **Environmental Monitoring Locations**


