Summary Update Jul – Oct 2016



- 26m deep shafts sunk Kennington Green– completed July 2016
- 15m of Sprayed Concrete Lining tunnels Back Shunt at Kennington Green – completed August 2016
- 142m of Sprayed Concrete Lining tunnels Front Shunt at Kennington Green – due for completion early November 2016



Preparation of Kennington Green running tunnel soft eye and excavation of Back Shunt




KG Programme and advance rate

- Finish of the SPJ works July 2017






