Kennington Park Jan – Mar 2016



- Piling works completed
- Breaking out of guide walls and concreting of the capping beams
- Pre-construction defect surveys continued
- On-going monitoring installations at identified locations

KP Look Ahead March – Jun 2016



- Foundations for acoustic enclosure and following installation of the structure.
- Breaking out of guide walls and concreting of Capping Beams.
- Installation of de-watering wells around the shafts and basement
- Tunnelling preparatory works





KP Thames Water Utilities Works End of March 2016



- Thames Water works planned from 29 March to 5 April by Kennington Park Place.
- 4 different liners. Trenchless operation Each installation will last for two days, maximum. Parking Suspensions will be needed.
- Two of these liners will be done under three and four way traffic lights.
- Works are to be undertaken after 9am (due to traffic) but due to the amount of connections within all of the runs, each length will more than likely run into a 12hr shift
- Traffic Management will come down at the end of each day
- More information to be sent out in advance








PHASE 1 Construction Activity Kennington Park – Piling works Zone of Influence (Zo|I) - Complete

- All the condition surveys within the Zol of the piling works for the shaft and the box have been completed already.






PHASE 2 – June – July 2016 Kennington Park – Excavation of the shaft






PHASE 3 – March – September 2018 Kennington Park – Excavation of the box.

Monitoring Results Summary


- 0 noise exeedances

KP Monitoring Locations









Noise Profile

Noise Time History: R3 - St Agnes' Place Residences Receptor



Kennington Park Working Hours



Core working hours are Monday-Friday 08:00-18:00* and Saturday 08:00-13:00, with shoulder hours either side of these for daily briefings, site set up/set down and maintenance.
