Year	Key milestones
2014	Transport and Works Act Order decision, Design & Build contract signed
2015	Agreement on Code of Construction Practice Part B, Start of main works at all sites
2016	Assembly of Tunnel Boring Machines
2017	Completion of tunnelling
2018	Fit out of new stations, Kennington shafts complete inc reinstatement, work at Kennington station complete
2019	Testing, commissioning, trial operations
2020	NLE complete and in service



# Summary Update June - Sept 2015



- Demolition of Banham's building
- Installation of hoarding and scaffold erection at the front of Banham's building
- Obstruction removal and build of piling platform and guide wall
- Piling enabling works (bentonite plant construction)
- Piling works in former Sainsbury's car-park
- Exit gate in Pascal Street for site traffic
- Hoarding graphics installed to TfL standards

- Continue piling works

- On-going monitoring installation
