Transport and Works Act 1992 Transport and Works (Applications and Objections Procedure) (England and Wales) Rules 2006 Proposed London Underground (Northern Line Extension) Order

Transport for London (TfL) hereby makes application to the Secretary of State for Transport for an Order under sections 1 and 5 of the Transport and Works Act 1992 in the terms of the draft Order accompanying this application.

The proposed Order authorises London Underground Limited (LUL) to construct and operate an extension to the Northern line (Charing Cross branch) from Kennington to Battersea, diverging from the existing railway south of Kennington station from a section of track used by terminating trains (known as the Kennington Loop). The Order also proposes the construction of permanent ventilation and intervention shafts and head houses, temporary shafts and construction tunnels, a terminus station at Battersea Power Station, an intermediate station in the Nine Elms area, the compulsory purchase and temporary use of land, the temporary stopping up of streets, street works and ancillary works. The proposed development is located in the London Boroughs of Lambeth, Southwark and Wandsworth.

This letter of application is accompanied by three copies of the letter and four copies of the documents particularised in the accompanying list of application documents, as prescribed by Rule 10 of the Transport and Works (Applications and Objections Procedure) (England and Wales) Rules 2006.
